### **Leviticus 19:33–34**

" . . . love the stranger (alien) as yourself; for you were once strangers in the land of Egypt." (Also Deuteronomy 10:17–19)

### **Deuteronomy 31:12–13**

"Gather the people together . . . and the stranger (alien) within your gates, that they may hear, and learn, and fear the Lord . . ."

### **1 Kings 8:41–43**

"Moreover concerning the stranger (foreigner) . . . do whatever the foreigner asks of you . . . that all peoples may know the name of the Lord. . ."

### **Isaiah 56:6–8**

"And foreigners who bind themselves to the Lord to serve Him . . . these I will bring to My holy mountain . . . and I will gather still others. . ."

### **Matthew 8:5–13**

". . . a Roman centurion came to Jesus asking for help . . . and Jesus said, 'I have not found anyone in Israel with such great faith.'"

### **Acts 2:5–11**

"Now there were staying in Jerusalem God-fearing Jews from every nation under heaven. . . each of us hears them in his own native language . . . declaring the wonders of God."

### **Acts 8:26–40**

"On his way Philip met an Ethiopian reading the Book of Isaiah. Then Philip began with that very passage of Scripture and told him the Good News about Jesus."

### **Acts 10: 1–33**

"There was a man in Caesarea named Cornelius he was a religious man."
